- **Note 1: Transfer course recommendations:** To ensure optimal transfer of credits, students are strongly encouraged to consult with an ODU enrollment counselor before registering for general education courses at WTCC. ENG 114 Prof Research & Reporting at WTCC will meet the ODU's ENGL 211C Written Comp II

requirement. MAT 152 Statistical Methods 1 at WTCC will meet the ODU Dental Hygiene math requirement for STAT 130 Elementary Statistics. BIO 169 Anatomy & Physiology II at WTCC will meet the ODU BIO 241 Fundamentals of Anatomy & Physiology II requirement.

- **Note 2: Departmental Chemistry Requirement.** The ODU Dental Hygiene program requires Introductory Chemistry with a lab. Students will need to complete this requirement at WTCC by taking CHM 131 Introduction to Chemistry and CHM 131A Introduction to Chemistry Lab which transfers to ODU as CHEM 105N Introductory Chemistry and CHEM 106N Introductory Chemistry Lab.
- **Note 3: ODU Humanities Requirement/WTCC Humanities Elective Options.** Before enrolling in an WTCC General Ed Arts/Humanities course, seek guidance from an ODU enrollment counselor to ensure transferability. Students who complete one of the following WTCC Humanities/Fine Arts Electives: ART 111 Art Appreciation, ART 114 Art History Survey I, or ART 115 Art History Survey II will meet 3 credits towards ODU's Humanities requirement.
- **Note 4: Transferability of DHY courses.** Credit hours from the Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene program are used to satisfy the BSDH Post-licensure Online Program as academic electives.
- **Note 5: Upper Division General Education.** Complete 15 credits at the upper division (300/400 level courses) to include a minimum of 6 credits to meet the Upper-Division General Education requirement.

General Notes:

- Completion of this transfer agreement guide alone does not guarantee admission to Old Dominion University. This guide is for advising and planning purposes only. Degree requirements are subject to change. Students should work with their ODU enrollment counselor or academic advisor to confirm transferability. An additional application is required specifically for the Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene (BSDH) Post-Licensure Online Program. Formal acceptance into the dental hygiene program will be determined by the Admissions Committee for the BSDH Post-Licensure Online Program.
- Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU. Students must notify their ODU academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.
- Grade of C or higher is required to receive transfer course credit from AAS courses, and all ODU Dental Hygiene (DNTH) courses require a C or higher.
- A minimum of 120 credit hours is required for graduation. Students must earn a minimum of 30 credits at Old Dominion University to be eligible for a degree.
- **Linked Bachelor's to Master's degree option:** Eligible students can apply to the Linked [Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene online program](#) to [Master of Science in Dental Hygiene online program](#). Qualified undergraduates can take up to 12 hours of graduate coursework that may be applied to both degrees.
- Course requirements listed in this agreement are based on the 2025-2026 catalogs for each institution and are valid until 2029, unless annual catalog curriculum changes or an updated agreement guide is created.
- **Students are encouraged to complete the Letter of Intent (LOI)** to gain access to exclusive benefits, including pre-advising, coaching, and a waived application fee. Submit the LOI at <https://online.odu.edu/transfer-intent>.
